

Basic Data Needs for Front Range Fuels Roundtable Implementation Team Mapping Project

1). All files submitted should be shape files. Metadata is preferred, but a simple description of data fields within shape file will suffice. Do not submit any .e00 files

2). No geodatabases please. If you have to submit a geodatabase please include instructions showing location of key files to be analysed.

3). If you are submitting multiple sets of data that were used to create a single analysis (e.g. watershed analysis for fire hazard) the following needs explained:

- Queries used for individual data sets.
- Clips, Joins, etc. used.

A final analysis data set with all of this work completed ahead of time is preferred.

4). Make sure all files submitted have a projection file (.prj).

5). If files are larger than 4megs please place on a cd and mail directly to the following address:

6). Please include dates with any ownership or land designation layer included (e.g. USFSWilderness_071209.shp. This will be important if future questions are raised regarding if a file shows a certain designation that occurred in recent history.
