

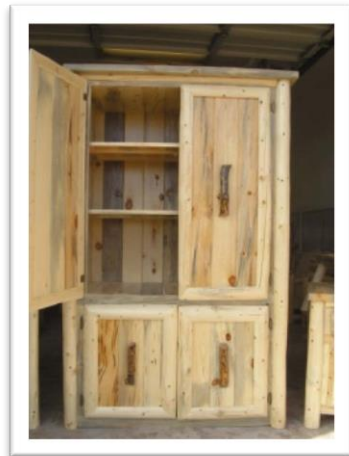
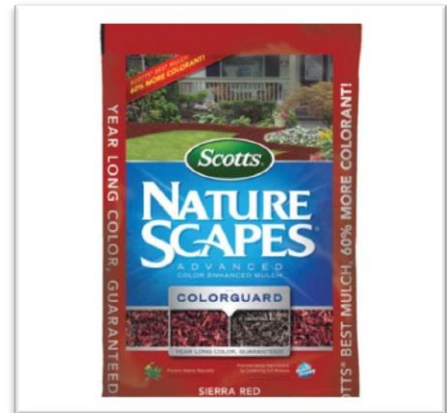

West Range Reclamation creates wood chips, mulch, bark fines and composted bark fines using a debarker, horizontal grinder, and tub grinder. Biomass is chipped at the landing in the forest or at our sort yard in Woodland Park, CO. Since 2010, West Range has supplied Scotts 250,000 yards of material, over 40% of the raw material used by this business.

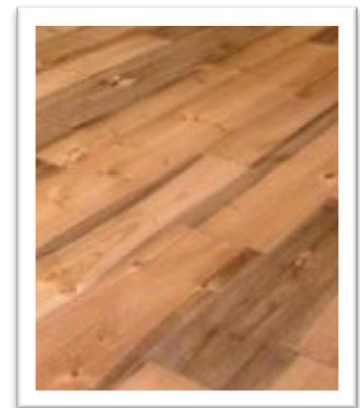

Waldo Canyon and High Park Fire Rehab, CO

In 2012 West Range was able to supply Woodshred mulch from nearby forest health and fuels treatments to the Forest Service Burned Area Emergency Response (BAER) team for aerial mulching emergency stabilization efforts in High and Moderate Soil Burn Severity areas. West Range supplied 8,600 tons of material for the Waldo Canyon Fire and 1,500 tons of material for the High Park Fire effort. This work will aid in mitigation efforts to reduce erosion and assist in the recovery of vegetative growth to protect communities within and surrounding the fire perimeter from floods, landslides, and debris flows.



West Range hopes to continue supplying material for wildfire rehab projects in the future.
