- 9:30 Welcome and Introductions. Travel to project site.
- 10:30 Messenger Gulch 2: Review a **post-treatment site**. The primary project site Biophysical Setting is Ponderosa Pine/Douglas-fir Woodland. Clumpiness was a component of the prescriptions. The treatment was implemented via **leave tree marking**.
- 12:00 Long John Project: Review a **post-treatment site**. The project site primary Biophysical Settings are Ponderosa Pine/Douglas-fir Woodland & Dry Mixed Conifer. This project included 2 sample mark areas that were set up in 2012 with an objective of creating “**clumpy**” **demo areas**.

- 1:30 Catamount 1: Review a **post-treatment site**. The project site primary Biophysical Settings are Ponderosa Pine/Douglas-fir Woodland & Dry Mixed Conifer. Some Mesic Mixed Conifer is present.
