#### **Public Meeting to Review Fall 2014 Heil Valley Ranch Prescribed Burn**

**What: Heil Valley Ranch Prescribed Burn After-Action Review Meeting**

**When:** Thurs., Jan. 29, 2015, 7 - 8:30 p.m.

**Where:** Boulder County Parks and Open Space, 5201 St. Vrain Road, Longmont 80503

**Boulder County, Colo.** – Staff from Boulder County Parks and Open Space and the Sheriff's Office Wildland Fire Management Program are hosting an After Action Review to discuss the outcome of the recent prescribed burn at Heil Valley Ranch.

In October and November, 2014, these agencies conducted a prescribed fire at Heil Valley Ranch. The 150-acre project was completed in early November after five days of ignitions.

Members of the public are invited to join the fire command staff for a presentation and question-and-answer session. This meeting is open to public comment, as well as input from fire personnel involved in the burn.
