LOGISTICS AND MAP

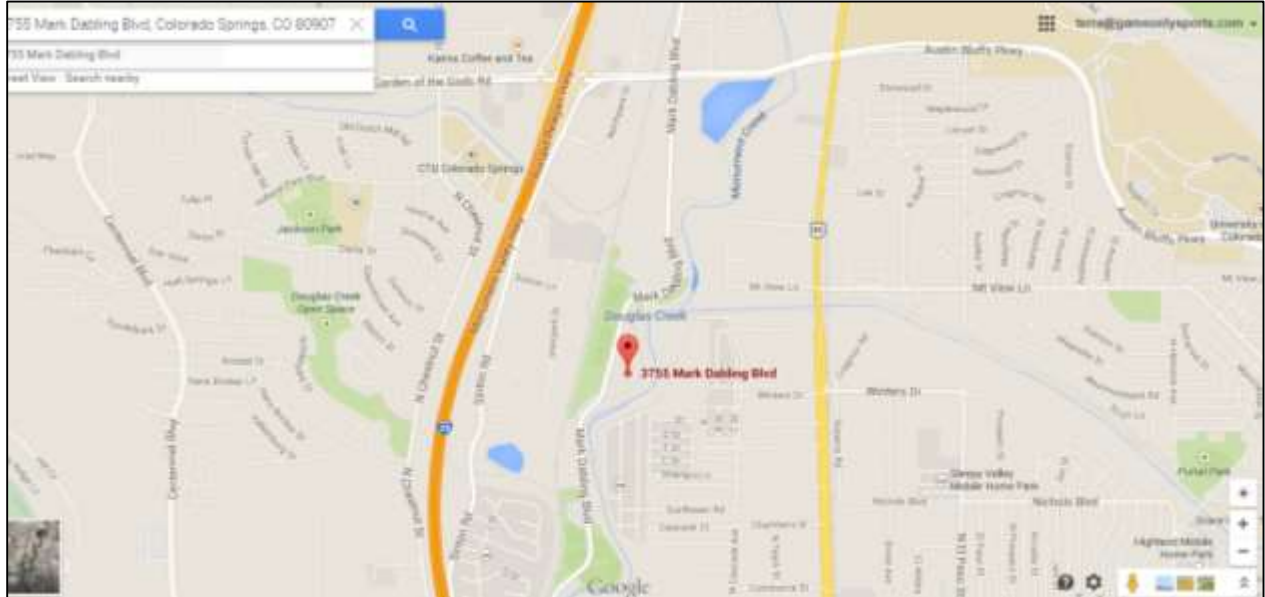
Lunch: Bring own or purchase nearby (30 minute break for lunch)
