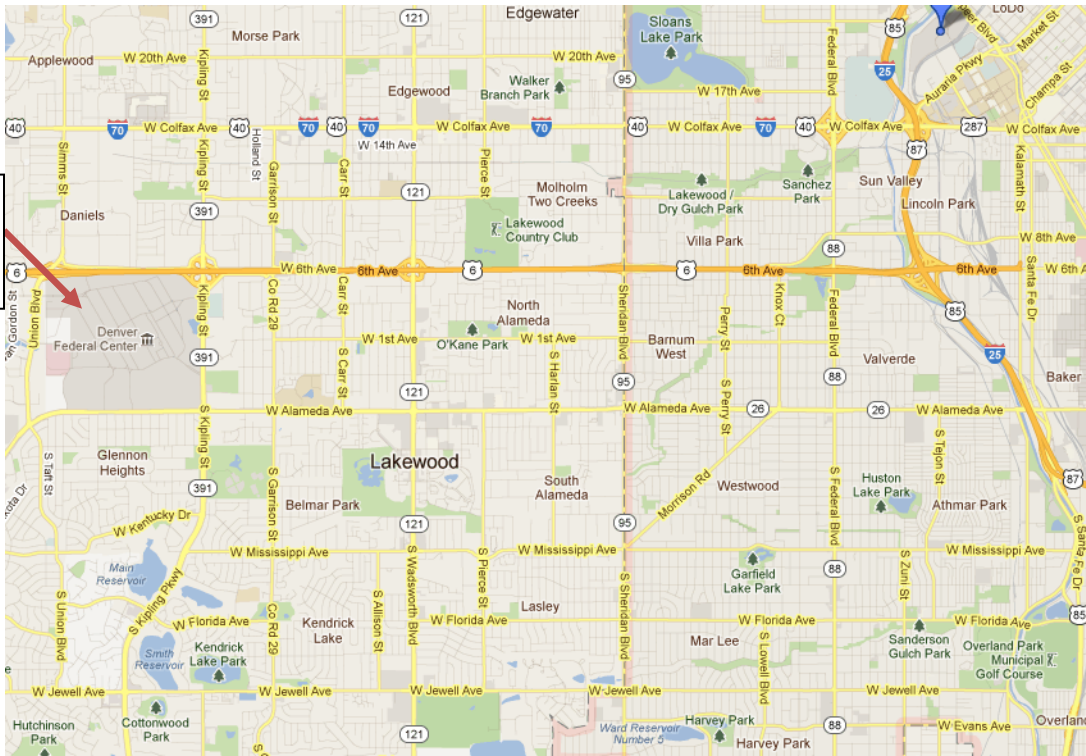
### From Boulder:

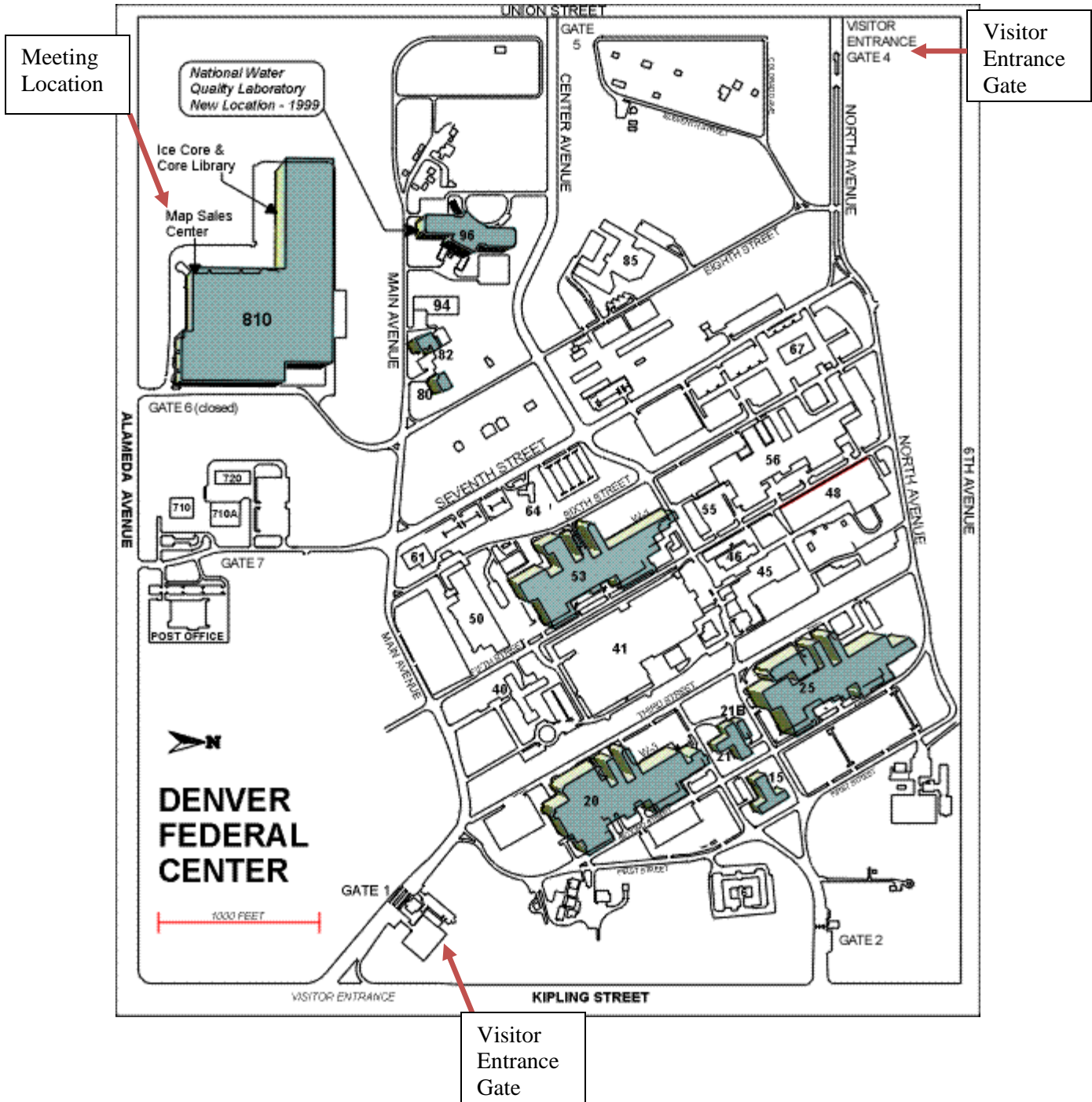

Continue onto 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. Exit onto CO-391 S/Kipling St., turn right onto Center Ave. and enter at Gate 1. Turn left onto Main Ave. and follow signs to Building 810. Enter the building either near the Map Sales area (door S13) or door W5.
