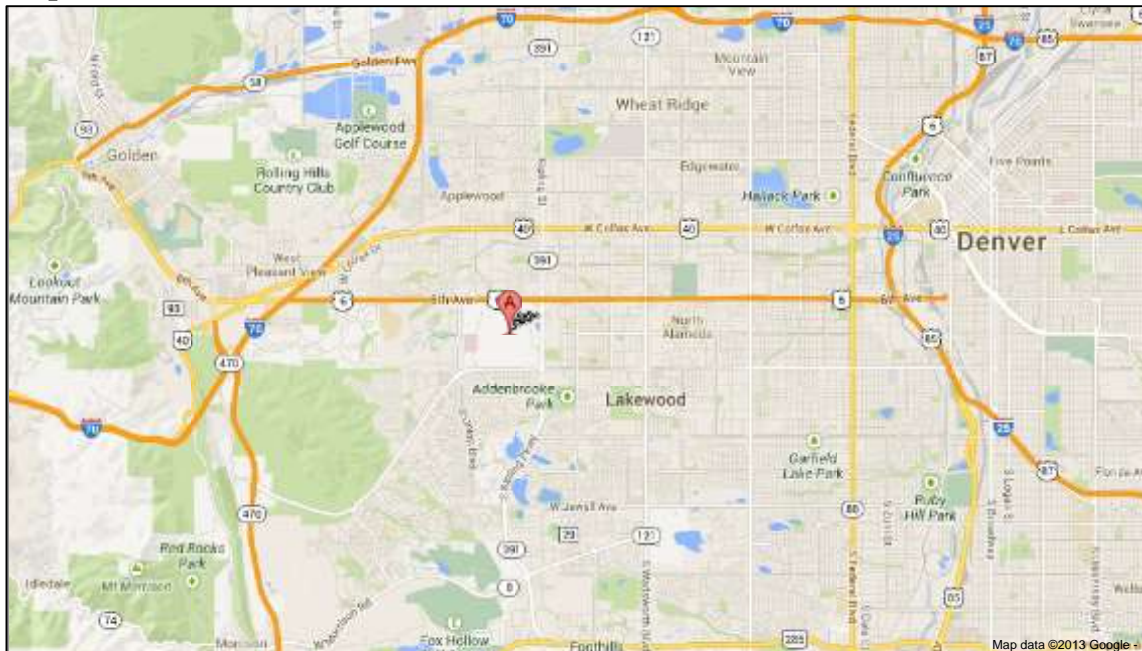
Lunch: Bring own or purchase nearby (20 minute break for lunch)
