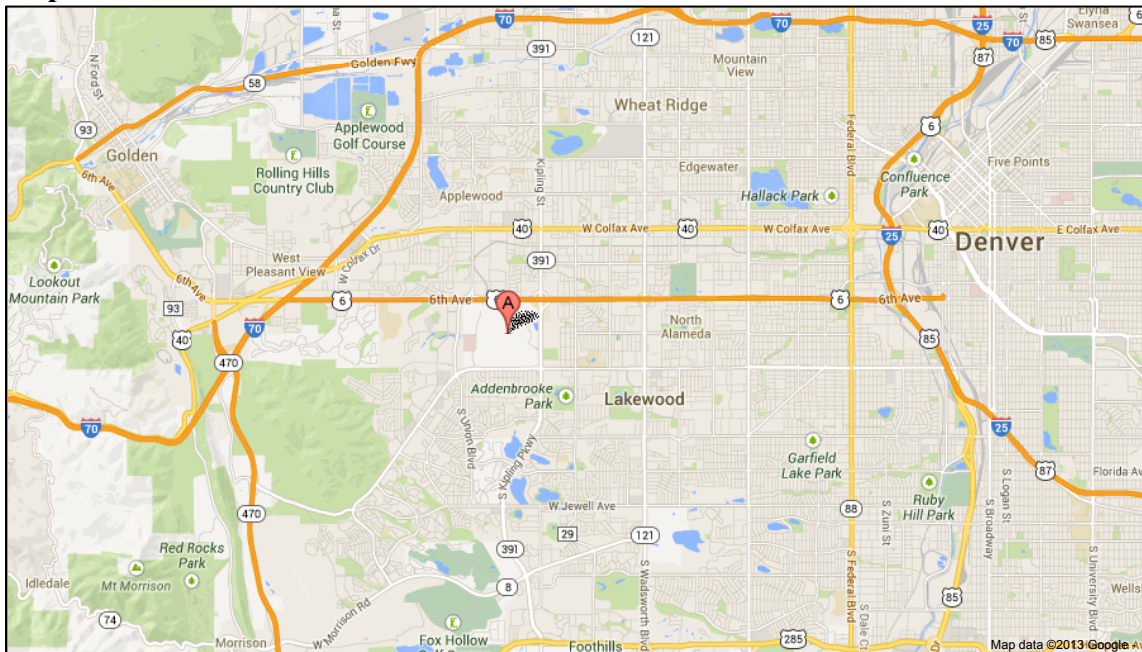
Lunch: Bring own or purchase nearby (20 minute break for lunch)

Take the first right, following signs to Building 25 (about 0.5 miles). Enter through door E14 (show ID to building guard) and the Lecture Hall is about 10 yards down the main hallway on the right.
