MEETING LOCATION

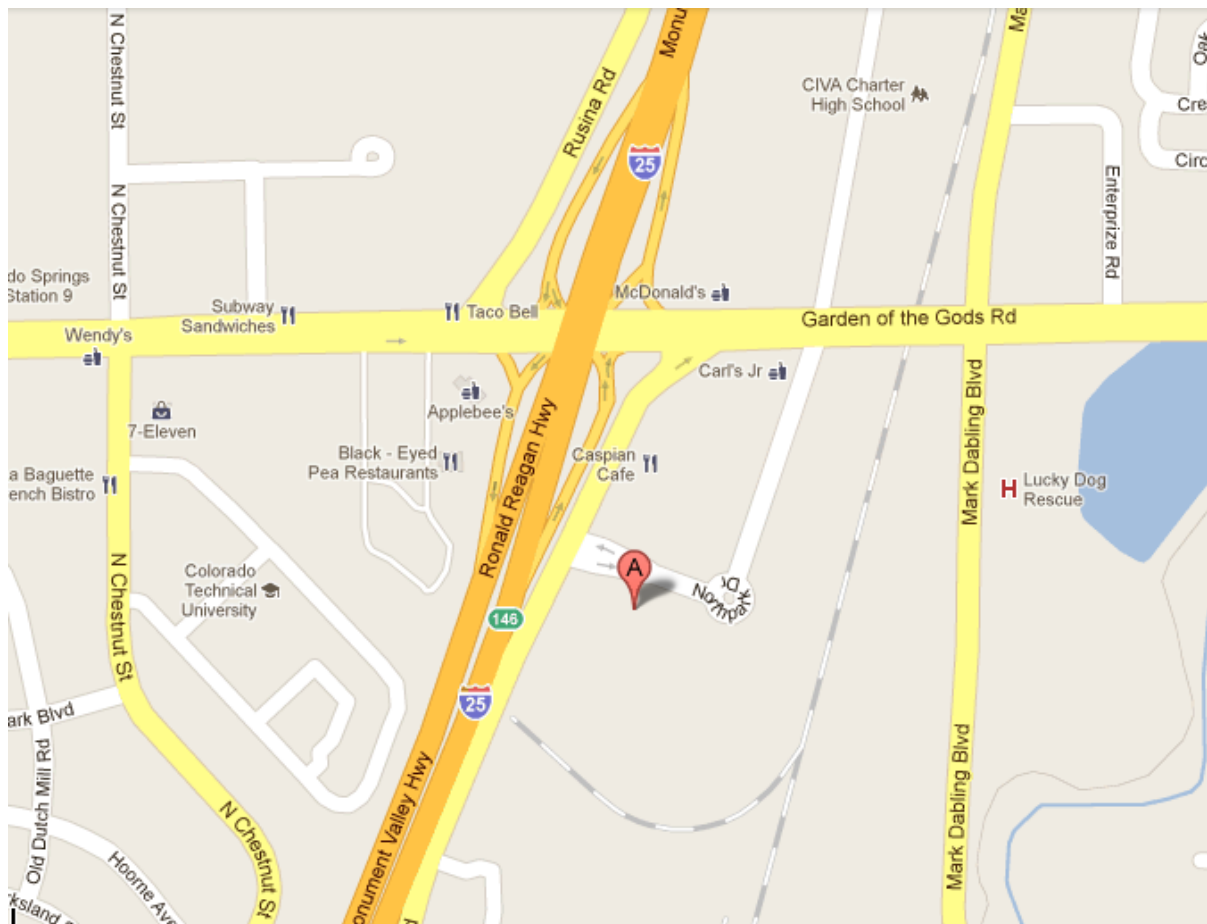
Colorado Division of Wildlife, "The Classroom," 4255 Sinton Road, Colorado Springs, CO
