## MEETING LOCATION

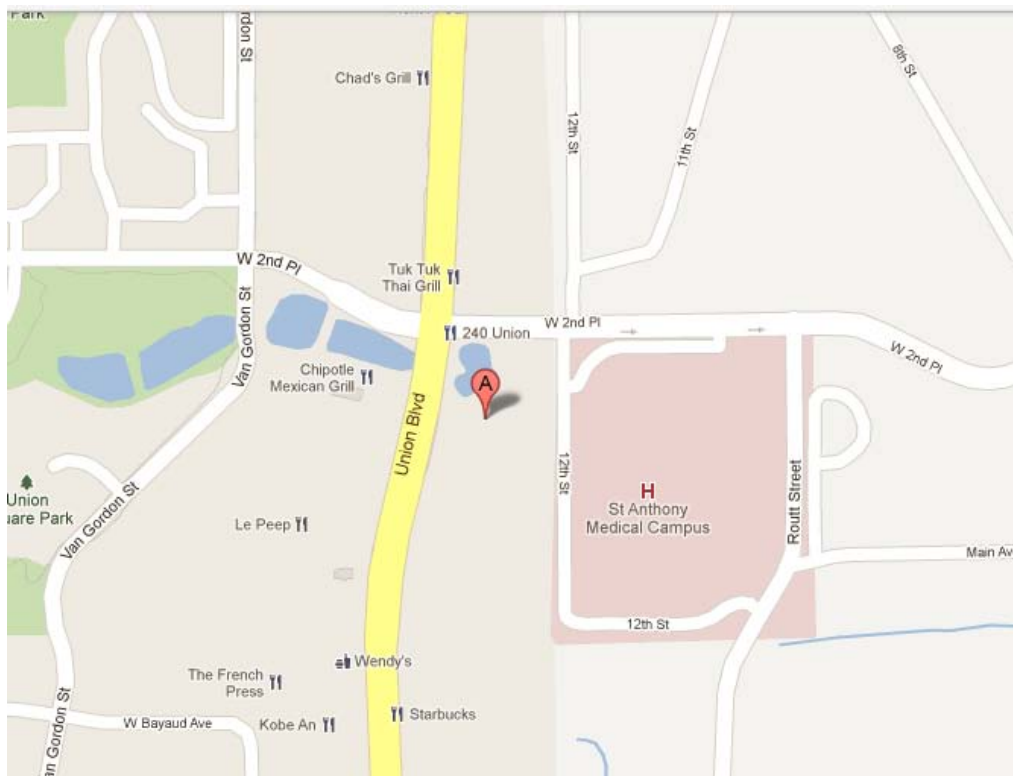

### From Boulder:

Take Interstate 36 east to Denver. Continue to follow Interstate 36E to the Denver Turnpike. Take the exit onto Interstate 25 south toward Denver. Take exit 209B for US-6 west/6<sup>th</sup> Ave toward Lakewood. As the road forks, keep left and follow signs for US-287 north/Colorado County 88/Federal Blvd and merge onto US-6 West. Take the Simms Street exit toward Union Blvd. Turn left onto Simms Street. Simms Street turns into Union Blvd. Make a U-turn and the US Fish and Wildlife Service will be on the right.

### From Colorado Springs, Pueblo:

Take Interstate 25 north to Denver. Take exit 209B for 6<sup>th</sup> Ave toward US-6 west/Lakewood. Merge onto 6<sup>th</sup> Ave Freeway. Continue onto US-6 West. Take the Simms Street exit toward Union Blvd. Turn left onto Simms Street. Simms Street turns into Union Blvd. Make a U-turn and the US Fish and Wildlife Service will be on the right.
